



A brand new, purpose-built 3,500 capacity entertainment and events venue


A range of different event configurations will be available including a fully seated layout for up to 2,100.

Derby Market Hall



Derby's Victorian Market Hall, a beautiful listed 19th century building, is being extensively repaired and refurbished into a **vibrant** destination in the heart of the city.


Flagship outdoor event showcasing immersive, innovative and ground-breaking performances
