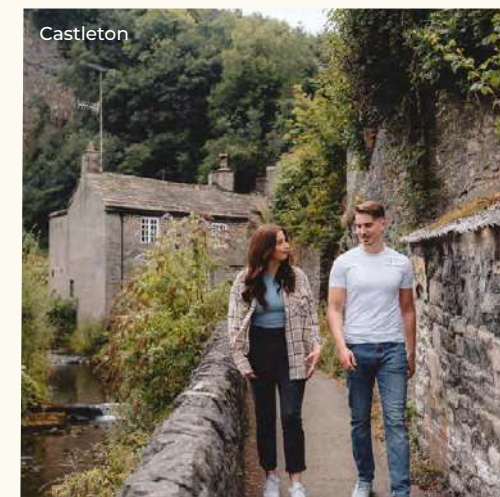

road, rail, air and boat – making it a perfect destination for both short breaks and extended itineraries.

Getting here



By Rail

The region is easily accessible by train, with direct services from major cities including London, Manchester, Birmingham and Sheffield. Regular services run from London St Pancras to Derby and Chesterfield, and from London Euston to Macclesfield, in under two hours. The Hope Valley Line runs through the heart of the Peak District National Park and links villages such as Edale and Hathersage with Manchester and Sheffield. The Derwent Valley Line connects Derby with Cromford and Matlock.



By Road

Travelling by road to the Peak District and Derbyshire is convenient, with direct motorway links via the M1 and M6. The region is centrally located at the heart of England, as little as 20 minutes from Sheffield, 45-90 minutes from Manchester, and 90 minutes from Birmingham. Once in destination, visitors can enjoy the freedom to explore with excellent public transport links. Coach parking is available in key towns such as Buxton and Bakewell.



By Air

Manchester, East Midlands, and Birmingham Airports are all within a 30 to 90-minute drive of the Peak District. From Manchester Airport, regular trains connect via the city centre to Peak District stations on the Hope Valley, Glossop, and Buxton lines, with direct buses to key areas. Manchester Airport provides Skylink bus links to Buxton. East Midlands Airport offers Skylink bus links to Derby station, which offers access to the Derwent Valley Line. Birmingham Airport offers rail connections through Birmingham to Derby, Chesterfield, and Sheffield.



By Ferry

Visitors arriving by ferry can travel via Hull and Liverpool, with connections from the Netherlands, Ireland, and Northern Europe. From the ports, the area is easily reached by road or rail, typically within a few hours.

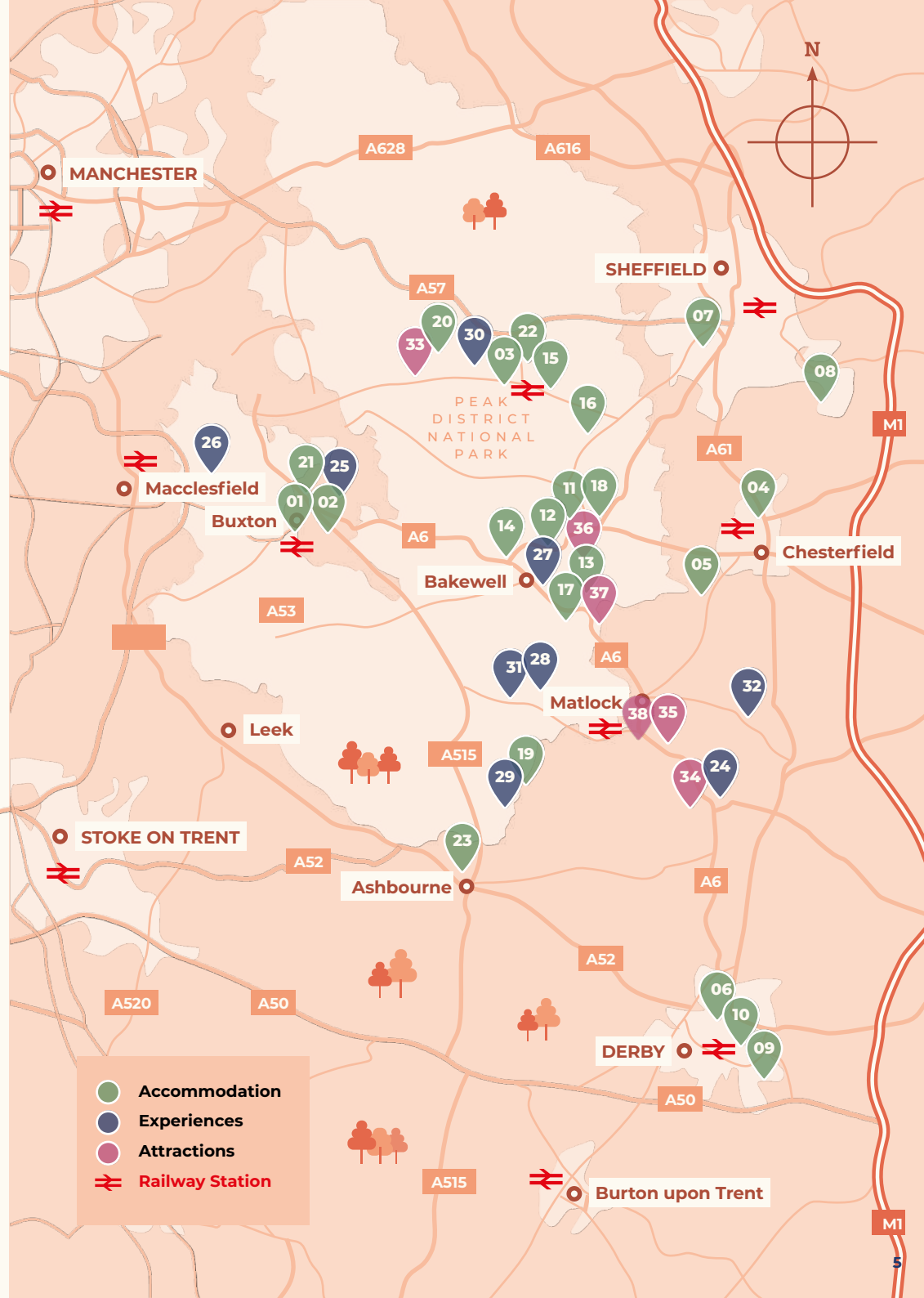
